grass, lumber, trash, etc.

Maximum Length - 6 Feet

Maximum Diameter - 8 Inches

NOTE: Do Not remove all your needles, they provide nutrients to the soil

Loads **MUST** be securely tied in transit.

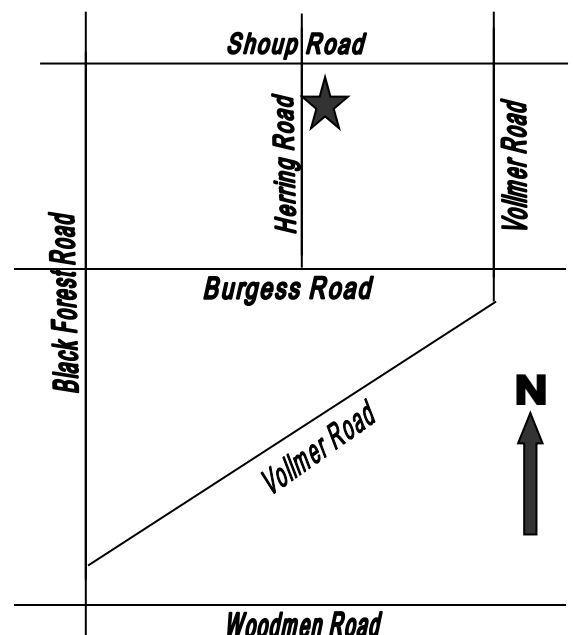
